3. **Supervisor Comments:** Supervisor Schafer provided an update on the Comprehensive Land Use Plan being conducted by Giffels Webster firm under contract with the Clinton County Planning Commission.
4. **Citizen's Comments:** Citizens shared comments and concerns regarding possible sale and development of a large section of property in Eagle Township.
5. **Consent Agenda:** Motion by Trustee Strahle and supported by Trustee Jones to approve the consent agenda as amended. Motion carried.
6. **Agenda Approval:** Motion by Trustee Jones supported by Trustee Strahle to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried.
7. **LGRFA Report:** John Clark reported that the facility is in good repair, and the parking lot was recently repaved. The LGRFA handles approximately 1200 runs per year with 80% of the runs being medical. LGRFA funding is split approximately 64% Watertown Township and 36% Eagle Township.
8. **Commissioner Report:** The 911 project to become part of statewide 911 has been completed. The spring Clean Community Event will be at the Clinton County Fairgrounds on April 29, 2023, and the Free for Fall Event will be October 7, 2023, at Granger Landfill on Wood St. The Clinton County courthouse is replacing the generator after 22 years. The January Ways and Means committee will be meeting on January 26, 2023, at 9 am to discuss the ITC powerline proposal from Isabella County to Oneida Township.

9. **Sheriff Report:** Sheriff Dush introduced himself and answered questions on Neighborhood Watch. He also reported that the Sheriff's department will perform property checks for snowbirds; contact Sheriff's Department. Deputy Spitler provided summary information on 911 calls in Eagle Township.
10. **Accounts Payable:** Motion by Trustee Strahle supported by Trustee Jones to pay the approved bills as presented as well as all other regular monthly bills. Motion carried.
11. **Looking Glass Clean-Up Project – Lloyd's Excavating, LLC/Truesdale:** No update at this time.
12. **Pension Resolution - Group Pension Plan Resolution 01-19-2023-01:** Motion by Trustee Jones supported by Trustee Strahle to adopt the presented resolution to update the Pension Plan to list Eligible Class employees as "Township Board Members and Appointed Deputies" effective August 1, 2014.
